- **Limited stabling** is available and allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. Stalls are 12 x 12 or larger permanent stalls with sliding doors.
- Main competition arena is 70m x 68m. Secondary competition arena is 80m x 25m. Main warm-up arena is 37m x 65m.
- **Footing in arenas** is sand, and will be watered and groomed throughout the day.
- Ribbons awarded for places 1st through 3rd. Prize for 1st for classes with 3 or more riders.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Per the USEF and our own facility requirements, all entrants of Woodland Stallion Station Dressage shows agree to abide by the following COVID-19 based safety protocols. These requirements may be changed, and riders and support staff should check the Woodland Stallion Station Shows home page for the most up to date information.

These guidelines are designed to ensure that our staff, volunteers, officials, and riders stay as safe as possible and can easily comply with CDC guidelines.

Failure to comply with any of these requirements at the request of a staff member or licensed official may result in ejection from the show grounds without refund.

- We request that entered riders bring with them only **one** support person (groom, trainer, coach, etc.)
- Participants and support personnel are required to self-monitor their temperature once per day prior to entering competition grounds. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5F (37.5 C) or higher may be denied entry to the facility.
- The following individuals are not allowed to enter competition grounds:
 - Anyone who exhibited COVID-19 symptoms
 - Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 10 days
 - Anyone who has tested positive outside of the last 10 days but is still symptomatic
 - *Anyone who has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days

* Exception: healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical-grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties are exempted from this restriction. Thank you for doing this amazing work.

- All individuals on show grounds are required to wear a face mask at all times when not mounted on a horse or during in-hand classes as outlined by the USEF.
 - To eat or drink, individuals must move far enough away from others to minimize possibility of being within six feet before lowering the mask.
 - Individual requests for modification to this face mask protocol must be submitted in writing to legalrequests@usef.org and show management should be copied, ridewss@gmail.com
 - Masks or face coverings with holes are not considered adequate.
- When mounted on a horse, riders are encouraged to have a face mask or covering on their person at all times. We suggest a mask that can be pulled down around the neck or placed in a pocket. This will minimize the time riders need to spend without a mask.
- Individuals must practice social distancing at all times while on competition grounds by staying at least 6 feet from any person who is not a member of their immediate household. Members of the same household are still required to wear masks at all times when on the grounds.
